To The Members of Omsfree Infratech Private Limited

Report on the Financial Statements

We have audited the accompanying financial statements of **Omsfree Infratech Private Limited** ('the Company'), which comprise the Balance Sheet as at 31st March, 2020, the Statement of Profit and Loss for the year then ended and a summary of the significant accounting policies and other explanatory information.




